WHO WE ARE:

We are the team behind Athens Comics Library. Comicdom Press was founded in 2004 and since then:

- we run the Greek, informative site for comics, www.comicdom.gr
- we organize the annual comics festival Comicdom Con Athens which attracts more than 15,000 visitors (since 2006 in collaboration with the Hellenic American Union and since 2016 with the French Institute of Greece)
- we founded the Athens Comics Library <u>www.athenscomicslibrary.gr</u>, the first comics lending library in Greece,
- we run the publishing company Comicdom Press (since 2007) with the aim of publishing selected comics, Greek and international creators,
- we organize workshops for students, teachers and librarians (since 2008, our workshops have been presented in more than 800 schools, libraries and cultural organizations throughout Greece),
- we organize workshops for adults using the comics collaborative storytelling methodology, with the aim of enhancing the collaborative spirit and creativity.

HISTORY:

Since the founding of the company until today, Comicdom Press has collaborated with organisations in Greece and abroad in the context of exhibitions, festivals, workshops, conferences, creators' mobility.

Examples include: Hellenic American Union, British Council, French Institute, Cervantes Institute, Embassy of Japan in Greece, National Book Center, General Secretariat for Youth, Panteion University, Cartoon Art Museum, Charles M. Schulz Museum, Israeli Cartoon Museum, Comics International Festival of Lodz, European Cultural Foundation etc.).

Finally, Comicdom Press, understanding the concept of social responsibility and solidarity, offers support to non-profit programs to Non-Governmental Organizations, Foundations and organizations with a social orientation (Make a Wish, Child's Smile, etc.), designs and delivers inclusive education programmes.



We value the importance of creativity for children 0-6 years old, which needs to be nurtured now more than ever.

For that reason we have created an edition of **creativity packs**, filled with art materials and creative resources, to be delivered to children across Athens and beyond.

Our packs aim to keep children engaged and creative during Covid-19 restrictions, and to ensure that children who are currently most in need of support do not miss out on the health, wellbeing, and educational benefits of creativity while away from school.



Writing, drawing, painting, storytelling, and comics can be a powerful means to mental **health** and nurtures our **belonging feeling**. Creating art allows us to disconnect from stress, express inner thoughts, and even meditate. In recent years, scientists have studied the positive effects art can have on our health. So far, the results are promising.

Practicing art requires **focus** and **concentration**. It is easy to become lost in thought as we paint, sketch, or write. This "flow" can help improve our mental health. Don't forget it is also **fun** and can help keep children **occupied** and **content** whilst at home.

WHY NOW?

At such a difficult and uncertain time, we know that parents and carers are facing unprecedented challenges. However, it's at times like these that we can come together to help each other. That's why we're created these home creativity packs. Our packs can be used by parents or carers looking to support their child's learning as well as by education staff.

Art connects us whilst we are navigating through this current crisis, in unexpected and imaginative ways. As the **COVID19** pandemic means we are unable to deliver our work face to face, we've created **Take Away Art** creativity packs for children delivered directly into their homes and to vulnerable children through our support networks of humanitarian organisations. This winter, with the coronavirus crisis continuing to unfold, our children will be unable to attend art courses, play groups or even school at some stage.

WHO IS IT FOR?

We hope these packs will raise a smile and offer an opportunity for **children** across Greece to have fun, learn and build bonds.

Also, for the many **parents** and **carers** currently working from home without any child care our activity packs will offer them the opportunity to focus on their work, whilst their children are occupied with our high-end quality creativity packs watching our unboxing videos. **Education professionals** and **organisations** could also incorporate our packs as part of their learning curriculum.

Companies can also reward and support their employees working from home, and offer an alternative form of childcare support by sponsoring those packs for their work force.

Athens Comics Library **designs**, **curates** and **produces** tailored made art packs for preschool children to access at home with their caregivers.

Parents working from home, now have the opportunity to share creative moments with their children, or encourage unsupervised creative time at home with our art kits and unboxing videos. We have chosen activities that ensure there are plenty of things for you to do without having to leave your home.

Each pack is delivered at your doorstep every month and our easy-steps guides and unboxing videos allow children to do the exercises with or without parental supervision. All exercises are **simple**, **safe** and most importantly **fun** and all materials and guidelines are included in the packs!

FINANCE:



TAKE AWAY ART packages are distributed free of charge to children at the Baytna Hub, but are also available for sale to all families.

Each pack **costs €25** including post.

For every 5 Take Away Art packages sold we offer 1 additional package to a vulnerable child who might have access to such an opportunity.

Our TAKE AWAY ART art packs are also available to educational and humanitarian organizations that would like to distribute those creativity packs during the new COVID19 safety measures to their beneficiaries whilst they cannot run their activities with a physical presence.

SOCIAL RETURN MODEL:
